Key to Programs and Sources of Funding:

- CILP** Cabrini Independent Living Program—20 scattered site apartments. (HUD)
- GRH/CC** Group Residential Housing***/Catholic Charities "Housing First"— individuals from streets & shelters. (Hennepini County and Catholic Charities)
- DHS** Department of Human Services—15-17 individuals dually diagnosed with chemical abuse and severe mental illness. (State of MN)
- S+C** Shelter Plus Care—9 scattered units for long term homeless. (HUD)
- ***** Hennepin County General Assistance funds the GRH program. The rules around employment is the immediate loss of GA, therefore preventing these individuals from employment opportunities at this time.
